

The acronyms 'PAIAS' will help you recall all the ocean names: Pacific Ocean, Atlantic Ocean, Indian Ocean, Arctic Ocean, and Southern Ocean. The oceans mentioned in the acronym are in the order of the largest to the smallest.

Oceans Zones

There are five distinct zones in an ocean. Each zone is home to different ocean creatures. The deeper we go, the darker and colder it becomes. This happens because the sunlight doesn't reach that far into the ocean.




Did You Know


Blue Whale is the largest creature on the Earth.


